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What does cpi training stand for

The purpose of this 24-week study is to determine whether the "crisis prevention Institute (CPI) physical management parent-based training program" (ie, P-CPI) is effective for increasing self-effectiveness In parents of children with autistic spectrum disorder (ASD). The purpose of this study is to evaluate whether "Crisis Prevention Institute (CPI) Parent-based physical management training program" (ie, P-CPI) for parents of children with ASD helps relieve some of this stress and Increase self-effectiveness parents, physical management competence, and the overall quality of life. Participants who meet criteria will be randomly assigned to the treatment group or the control group waitlist. Participants assigned to the treatment group will be invited to a 6-hour P-CPI group training session. This parent-based training in non-violento interventiioni â of the CPI will include non-verbal, paravable, verbal and physical intervention techniques. The participants assigned to the waiting list group will be encouraged to continue their existing medical assistance, or services, as usual. The waiting list group will be invited to participate in the P-CPI training at the conclusion of the post-evaluation period. Basic measures will be the day of training for the treatment group and within five days of the P-CPI training for the waiting list group. Follow-up measures will be at 2 weeks, and 1, 2, and 3 months post-basal. The treatment group also will participate in a follow-up group interview. Intervention arm / experimental treatment: CPI-parent training will receive a day of training (6 hours) in P-CPI including the use of, paravera trees, non-verbal verbal intervention techniques. Behavioral: Parent-based Crisis Prevention Institute (CPI) training program physical management (P-CPI) Parents of children with ASD will be randomly assigned to the P-CPI 6 hours group training session, which includes non-verbal , Paravebale, Minutes, and physical intervention techniques.
