These passive publishers who make only a single change per month see about a quarter of their changes deleted or modified by other more active publishers (the rate was only 10% in 2003). The resulting exclusion of the most varied contributions shifts the balance of power on Wikipedia to those less active editors, and in turn could make Wikipedia more like a fraternity than a community-led social encyclopedia. Over time, the Palo Alto team warns, the quality of Wikipedia could degrade when there were fewer publishers controlling errors and correcting vandalism accompanying user-gen websites. The Wikipedia management has launched an internal review to give a sense to data, but claims that numbers might deceive.
